JUDGING CRITERIA

Applications will be scored on the following criteria:

1. Originality
2. Impact
3. Robustness of approach
4. Strength of team
5. Project achievable within 12 months

APPLICATION PROCESS

Your application should describe your proposed project involving the use of SmartSocks®DISCOVERY in no more than 1,300 words. Please use the application form provided (in Microsoft Word format) to enter your responses. There are eight questions on the application form:

1. What is the title of your project? [max. 50 words]
2. Which prize category applies to your project?
3. What is the central research question or problem your project aims to address? [max. 250 words]
4. What are the objectives and expected outcomes of the proposed research? [max. 250 words]
5. What is the methodology or approach you will use to conduct the research? [max. 250 words]
6. How does the research contribute to the existing body of knowledge or solve a real-world problem? [max. 250 words]
7. What is the timeline and work plan for completing the project? [max. 250 words]
8. What are the qualifications of the research team?

Completed application forms must be emailed to discovery-pioneers@milbotix.com in Microsoft Word or PDF format on or before the closing date of 30th November 2025.

Applications will be shortlisted by Milbotix before passing to an independent judging panel which will select the winner and runner up in each category.

Only original research proposals involving the use of SmartSocks®DISCOVERY will be considered. Projects should be completable in 12 months. SmartSocks®DISCOVERY may be used to capture data from one or both feet simultaneously.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Applications should be 1,300 words or less. The maximum word limit is a guide.

Prizes are as stated in the Information for Applicants in the main body of this document above.

There is no limit on the number of applications an individual can submit.

Each application can only be entered once into the Competition.

Each application must be entered into one prize category:

1. Dementia and other neurological disorders

Submissions that have been previously published cannot be submitted.

All applications must be in English.

Milbotix reserves the right to disqualify any applications which are not of acceptable quality.

Applications will remain confidential to Milbotix and the judging panel.

Milbotix reserves the right to use the project title in promotional material.

COPYRIGHT AND PERMISSIONS

The applicant or their representative applying on their behalf must be the copyright holder or have permission from the copyright holder to apply to the Competition under the Terms and Conditions specified here.

Copyright holders retain copyright in their work.

Copyright holders grant to Milbotix a non-exclusive, worldwide, irrevocable right to copy, adapt, distribute, perform and use the submitted project title (as outlined in the Information for Applicants in the main body of this document above) in any media (including social media, online and print): in connection with the operation, promotion and/or description of the Prize for a period of 3 years from the date of submission.

The above licence will be royalty free.

The applicant or their representative applying on their behalf warrants they have all third-party permissions and releases, including patient consent if relevant.

The applicant or their representative applying on their behalf warrants that any material submitted is their own original work and does not infringe the copyright or any other rights of any third party.

JUDGING AND PRIZES

All judging decisions are final.

The winners and runners up will be informed by email on or before 5th January 2026.

If a Prize winner or runner up cannot be contacted within seven days of the judges' decision, Milbotix reserves the right to award the Prize to another entrant.

Milbotix reserves the right to exclude an entry and revoke any Prize made, at any time, in the event of a breach of these Terms and Conditions by the relevant entrant.
